

Process for the prescribing and dispensing of Fosfomycin 3g oral sachets in the management of urinary tract infection in the community

Oral fosfomycin (3g sachets) is an option for patients with urinary tract infection, to be prescribed on the recommendation of a consultant microbiologist for an individual named patient, when alternative options have been considered and are not clinically appropriate for the patient.

Oral fosfomycin (3g sachets) may not be routinely stocked in community pharmacy to be dispensed on the same day.
